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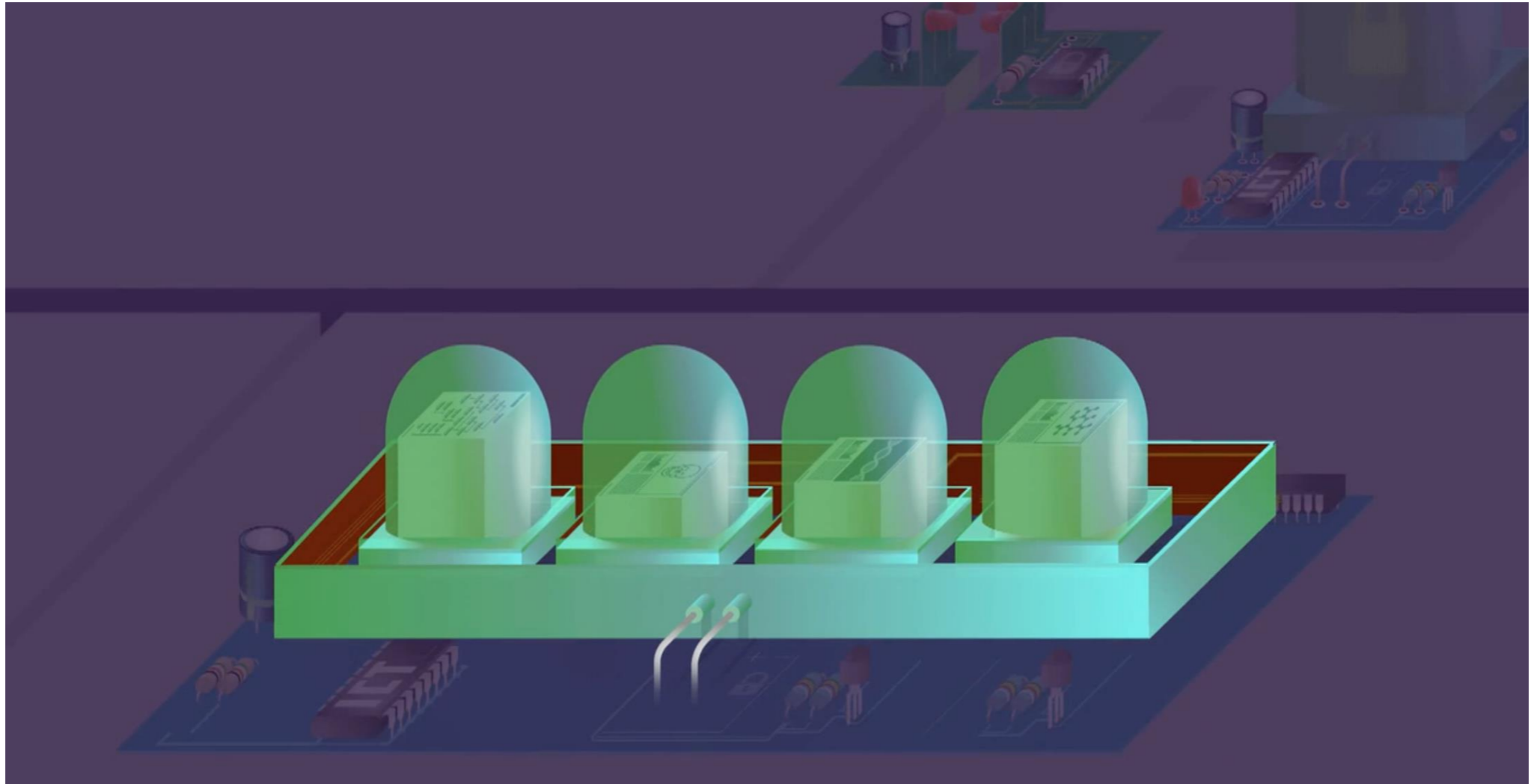

- FAIR, distributed learning data infrastructure
- “Visiting data” rather than “sharing data”



- **Patient owned data stations.**
- **Patient controls access (activities are logged).**
- **Patient identity is secure (as desired, required).**
- **Patient is an active force in discovery process.**



- You manage the key to your data.
- The cooperative will take care of the collective utilization of that data for you, in the interest of you.
- Proceeds will be reinvested in a new health economy: an economy that has an interest in your health instead of your illness.





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
